JAPANESE STILTGRASS

HABITAT: variable but often
moist, shaded areas

Plants sprawling and freely branched

Invasive grass up to 1 m tall

WHERE TO LOOK:

- PARKS
- TRAILS
- ROADSIDES
- PASTURES
- FORESTS
- DISTURBED AREAS
- AREAS WITH ESTABLISHED
DEER POPULATIONS

Distinct shiny midrib

JAPANESE STILTGRASS *(Microstegium vimineum)*

Plants flower
and seed
in mid to
late autumn



Leaves turn purplish
in late autumn



Dead, straw-coloured stems
persist through winter

Tapered leaves about 7 cm long
